Antimicrobial Use/Antimicrobial Resistance

Council received a letter of support for the recommendations included in "Antimicrobial Stewardship in Food Animals in Canada" published earlier this year from the Canadian Association of Bovine Veterinarians. The support of stakeholders in animal agriculture is required for implementation of the recommendations.
