### **BTSF**: Better training for safer food

A DG SANTE **training initiative** since 2005 for EU and non-EU official control staff, sometimes stakeholders

**Objective:** High levels of competence and knowledge of EU rules leading to harmonised approach to control systems and enforcement, facilitating trade and market access




### How do we achieve training objectives?

### Specific objectives for non-EU training

- Ensure fair trade with non-EU countries, particularly developing countries
- Enhance SPS regulatory cooperation with non-EU countries
- Help non-EU countries to better understand and meet more easily EU rules/standards
- Reduce rejections at EU borders and facilitate access to the EU market
- Contribute to safer food for non-EU country consumers and a more diverse range of safe food products in the EU





## BTSFactivities in non-EU countries

#### **ANTIMICROBIAL RESISTANCE**

to develop cooperation activities on AMR at international level with a view to promote a 'One-Health' approach for addressing AMR in both humans and animals

#### **AGRI-FOOD FRAUD**

- to develop cooperation activities with non-EU trade partners
- to improve the effectiveness of official control systems dealing with agri-food fraud, including Internet sales, and their ability to detect fraud

#### **NOVEL FOODS**

to raise awareness and contribute to a better understanding of existing EU rules applicable to the authorisation and placing on the market of novel foods

#### **FOOD SAFETY CRISIS PREPAREDNESS**

to deepen the collaboration (including through INFOSAN) between EU and non-EU countries in the management of food safety crises, taking stock of the experience and achievements in the EU and beyond

#### **IMSOC**

to further raise awareness and contribute to a better understanding and more efficient use of existing EU SPS information management systems

#### **RISK ANALYSIS**

to develop cooperation activities on risk analysis at international level with a view to ensure the establishment of scientifically sound food safety control systems



### BTSF activities in non-EU countries

#### Regional workshops

### 28 four-day workshops, 1.08/1.540 participants

- Trade-facilitating, trade-oriented
- Seeking reciprocity (import vs. export) with full day on EU SPS system to focus on its robustness
- Result oriented: selection of beneficiaries
- to further raise awareness and contribute to a better understanding and more efficient use of existing EU SPS information management systems

### **Sustained Training Missions**


### 770 STM days in 15 non-EU countries

- Tailor-made interventions for the beneficiary
- Organised in consecutive follow-up missions in the same country on the same subject
- Targets: Competent Authorities or the private sector

Monthly view of Page views from EU Analytics – May 2023


